- ✦ Travel to the Cape of Good Hope combined with sea kayaking to the Penguin Colony at Boulders Beach, take a boat trip to see Cape Fur Seals up close, or an interactive experience with a troop of Chacma Baboons.
- ✦ Collect gemstones at Scratch Patch and Mineral World, visit the Cape Point Ostrich Farm, the Imhoff Snake and Reptile Rehabilitation Park, or The World of Birds.
- ✦ Excursion up to the top of Table Mountain, with bird’s-eye views. Also visit the Cape Malay Quarter, Company Gardens, the Two Oceans Aquarium and Signal Hill.
- ✦ Tour the scenic Winelands, including a visit to Butterfly World, and Spier Estate, where both parents and kids can experience an up-close encounter with the cheetahs in the care of the Cheetah Outreach Program.

The Enchanting Temples of Angkor

Maybe best known to Americans as where “Tomb Raider” and “Two Brothers” were filmed, your family will explore the ancient Angkor Temple Complex, and the more remote temples. Ride elephant-back to watch the sun set over awesome Angkor Wat; go hot air ballooning. Tour nearby Tonle Sap Lake and its floating villages—even floating schools!
