This famous off-road cross-country endurance race will start in Buenos Aires, Argentina, Jan. 3, 2009. Drivers will first take course for Patagonia, circle the Pampa and then cross the Andes Mountains. ## World Heritage Sites — Nepal

- ♦ **Kathmandu Valley:** The cultural heritage of the Kathmandu Valley is illustrated by seven groups of monuments and buildings, which display a full range of historic and artistic achievements. These include the Durbar Square, Patan and Bhaktapur, the Buddhist stupas of Swayambhu and Bauddhanath, and the Hindu temples of Pashupati and Changu Narayan.
- ♦ **Sagarmatha National Park:** With dramatic mountains, glaciers and deep valleys, this exceptional area is dominated by Mount Everest, the highest peak in the world. Several rare species, such as the snow leopard and the lesser panda, are found in the park.
- ♦ **Royal Chitwan National Park:** Chitwan is one of the few remaining undisturbed vestiges of the Terai region, which formerly extended over the foothills of India and Nepal. The park has one of the last populations of single-horned Asiatic rhinoceros, and is one of the last refuges of the Bengal tiger.
- ♦ **Lumbini, the Birthplace of the Lord Buddha:** As the birthplace of the Lord Buddha, Lumbini is one of the holiest places of one of the world's great religions, and contain important evidence about the nature of Buddhist pilgrimage centers from a very early period.
