This safari will take you across baobab-strewn Tarangire Park with its vast herds of elephants, around flamingo-covered Lake Manyara, into the indescribable Ngorongoro Crater, and onto the famed plains of the Serengeti. You’ll have a chance to meet the captivating Masai in their villages and view spectacular scenery from light aircraft. We’ve chosen the best small, intimate, luxury safari camps and well-appointed lodges for their prime locations, and access to where the drama unfolds daily—where predators prey on vast herds of grazers. Witnessing the annual zebra and wildebeest

migration in the Serengeti is the ultimate wildlife experience. Annual rainfall patterns dictate the movements of the migrating herds. There is a choice of Superior or Deluxe accommodation throughout the safari.

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THE ELEPHANT HERDS AND MAJESTIC BAOBABs OF TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

The open plains of Tarangire are dotted with thousands of baobabs and are home to some of Africa's largest herds of elephants. The permanent water of the river attracts these and other animals by the tens of thousands. Here, the emphasis is on wildlife, culture, and walking safaris. On night game drives, you have the opportunity to seek out rarely seen nocturnal animals.

PREDATOR VERSUS PREY ON THE SERENGETI PLAINS

The immense, open grasslands of the Serengeti are without a doubt one of Africa's finest wildlife areas, and being there at the height of the migration is a never-to-be-forgotten experience. Search for Africa's Big Five—leopard, lion, elephant, buffalo and rhino. Your experienced guide takes you to the best spots for sighting game, and affords you ample time to take photographs and to fully absorb every moment.

LIONS AND FLAMINGOS OF LAKE MANYARA

Lake Manyara National Park is made up of an incredible natural diversity of rift valley lake, dense woodlands and steep mountainside landscapes. The park offers abundant sightings of wildlife such as zebra, hippo, buffalo, giraffe, waterbuck, impala, hyena and jackal. Manyara is also known for its wealth of bird life, especially Lesser and Greater Flamingos, as well as its famed tree climbing lions.

WILD ABUNDANCE INSIDE THE NGORONGORO CRATER

Great buttressed slopes rise above the plains to plummet downward into the ancient caldera of the Ngorongoro Crater. This perfect natural amphitheater, bound by 2,000-foot cliffs, covers an area of 100 square miles and has approximately 30,000 larger mammals—almost half of which are zebra and wildebeest.

DETAILS AND PRICING

From \$6,815 per person double occupancy. Includes all accommodation with breakfast daily, full board dining daily and all activities included by private vehicle while on safari, and road transfers, services of naturalist guides for all sightseeing and game viewing. Private Safaris depart daily subject to availability.

TRAVEL ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive at the Kilimanjaro International Airport. Met and transferred by road to Arusha, *Serena Mountain Village* or *Arusha Coffee Lodge*.

Day 2: Drive to Tarangire National Park and your first safari camp or lodge. This afternoon embark on your first activity, *Tarangire Sopa Lodge* or *Oliver's Camp*.

Day 3: Early morning and late afternoon activities in Tarangire National Park, *Tarangire Sopa Lodge* or *Oliver's Camp*.

Day 4: Drive to Lake Manyara National Park. This afternoon embark on a game viewing activity, *Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge* or *Lake Manyara Tree Lodge*.

Days 5: Early morning and late afternoon game drives in Lake Manyara National Park, *Lake Manyara Serena Safari Lodge* or *Lake Manyara Tree Lodge*.

Day 6: Drive through the Tanzanian highlands into the Ngorongoro Conservancy. This afternoon enjoy the magnificent views from your lodge on the crater rim or alternately you may choose to visit one of the local Masai communities, *Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge* or *Ngorongoro Crater Lodge*.

Day 7: Day trip to the Ngorongoro Crater with its astounding wildlife including elephants and black-maned lions. Ngorongoro happens to be the best location in Tanzania to view black rhino! Return to your lodge on the rim of the crater, *Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge* or *Ngorongoro Crater Lodge*.

Day 8: Drive through the vast Serengeti plains to the Serengeti National Park, enjoying a game drive en route, *Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge* or *Grumeti River Camp*.

Days 9 & 10: Early morning and late afternoon game drives in the Serengeti. Early morning hot air ballooning is an optional activity available at an additional cost, *Serengeti Serena Safari Lodge* or *Grumeti River Camp*.

Day 11: Fly to Arusha and depart Tanzania.
