Founded in the early 18th century, *Ouro Preto* was the focal point of the gold rush and Brazil's golden age. *Ouro Preto* is also a masterpiece of colonial Brazilian architecture and art. In fact, UNESCO has declared it a World Heritage Site for its baroque architecture. Here the intricate details of the buildings and art work clearly reflect the originality and autonomy of the craftsmen and artists who created this monument of Brazilian baroque style. The *paintings of Manuel da Costa Athaide*, the *sculptures of Antônio Francisco Lisboa*, and *Aleijadinho*, are living examples of this period of enormous creative inspiration.

Day One Arrive Belo Horizonte

Upon arrival in Belo Horizonte, your Cox & Kings representative will transfer you to Ouro Preto (2 hours) and to the hotel for check in. Your hotel is located in front of the Rosario church in the heart of Ouro Preto. **The Solar Nossa Senhora do Rosario (Double Room)**

Day Two Ouro Preto

Today enjoy a tour of Ouro Preto. Visit the *church of St. Francis of Assis*, with its richly sculptured door and the *church of our Lady of Carmel*, as well as the *City Hall* and the *Pillory* can be found at the *Minas Gerais Plaza*.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Afterward, visit the picturesque town of **Mariana**. Mariana, also known as the enchanted city, was founded in 1696. For a short time, it was the capital of the state of Minas Gerais, and it was known as the Royal Village of Our Lady of Carmel. In 1745, it received its present name in honor of Queen Maria Ana. A walk down its picturesque streets allows you to see houses that date back from the beginning of the 18th century, with their balconies of wood, iron, and even soapstone. **The Solar Nossa Senhora do Rosario (Double Room) (B, L)**

Day Three Depart Ouro Preto

Following breakfast, you will return to Belo Horizonte for your flight elsewhere in Brazil.
