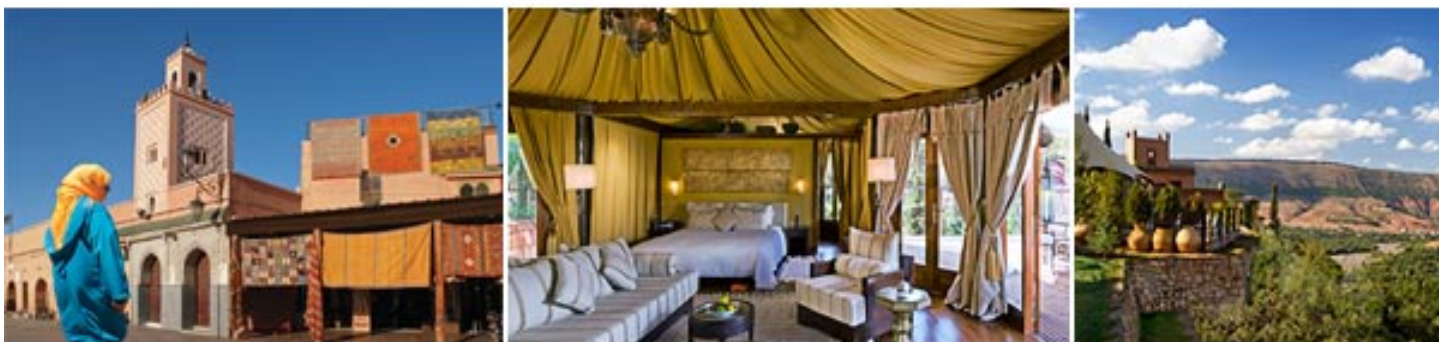

## UNESCO World Heritage Sites—Ecuador

### Galápagos Islands

These islands and surrounding marine reserve are a melting pot of marine species. The extreme isolation of the islands led to the development of unusual animal life that inspired Charles Darwin's theory of evolution by natural selection following his visit in 1835.

### City of Quito

The capital of Ecuador was founded in the 16th C on the ruins of an Inca city and stands at an altitude of 9,350 feet. The city has the best-preserved, least altered historic center in Latin America.

### Sangay National Park

The park covers the entire spectrum of ecosystems, ranging from tropical rainforests to glaciers. Its isolation has encouraged the survival of indigenous species such as the mountain tapir and the Andean condor.

### Historic Center of Santa Ana de los Ríos de Cuenca

This inland colonial town was founded in 1557 and is an outstanding example of a planned inland Spanish colonial city.
