### Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu

Likely the most amazing urban creation of the Inca Empire at its height; its giant walls, terraces and ramps seem as if they have been cut naturally in the continuous rock escarpments.

### City of Cusco

Developed under the Inca rule into a complex urban center with distinct religious and administrative functions. When the Spaniards conquered it in the 16th C, they preserved the basic structure but built Baroque churches and palaces over the ruins of the Inca city.

### Historic Center of Lima

Until the middle of the 18th C, the city was the most important city of the Spanish dominions in South America.

### Historic Center of Arequipa

The ornamented architecture in the historic centre of Arequipa represents a masterpiece of the creative integration of European and native characteristics, crucial for the cultural expression of the entire region.
