### Seychelles: Boulders, Beaches and Ancient Wonders

The Seychelles islands rest nearly 1,000 miles off the east coast of Africa, just south of the Equator, with about 115 granitic and coral islands. There are large islands and small, private islands, prehistoric jungles, a focus on endemic plants and wildlife, and pristine beaches awash with balmy, blue water and dotted with massive boulders.



### Mauritius: Lush Landscapes, Crystal Seas & Colorful Cultures

Mauritius sits just north of the Tropic of Capricorn. It is a single island with a perimeter of white beaches and a center of lush green. Sugarcane fields line the highways, mountains rise up from the ocean and Hindu temples are a common and colorful sight.



### Mozambique: Beach Safari Ambience

The Bazaruto and Quirimbas Archipelagos off the coast of Mozambique are two of the most acclaimed diving and fishing locales in the world. Both are protected marine areas with dhow-flecked coasts and a safari-style ambience.



### Zanzibar: The Spice Islands

The archipelago of Zanzibar was once part of the spice trade route, and traditional Arab dhows still parade its coasts today. Experience a true beach safari replete with spice markets, Persian baths and remarkable diving.



## Madagascar: Undiscovered Islands

With incredible biodiversity and undiscovered charm, the country offers a unique cultural, wildlife and private island experience. Surreal tropical islands in the northwest feature spacious wooden bungalows, migrating whales, nearby villages and nesting sea turtles.



## Maldives: For Every Island, One Resort

The 26 atolls and nearly 1,200 islets of the Maldives are located about 435 miles off the southwestern tip of Sri Lanka. Known for an abundance of over-water accommodation, the many luxury resorts each occupy a single, private island and offer everything from nightclubs and haute cuisine to over-water yoga platforms and world-renowned diving.
