The next day we cross the Victoria Falls into Zambia, Lusaka, the Luangwa valley and on to the incredible Tazara Railway line before arriving at Dar Es Salaam in Tanzania.

The one-way 3800-mile journey will take 13 days. Once there, guests have the option of visiting exotic Zanzibar, Mount Kilimanjaro, the Ngorongoro Crater and the wildlife paradise of the Serengeti. The Edwardian Safari will then depart Dar Es Salaam again traveling with its southbound guests back to Cape Town, an authentic African adventure.

After border formalities travel through Zimbabwe with morning & afternoon lectures provided by the historian.

11h00 Arrive at the Victoria Falls. Transfer from Station to the Victoria Falls Hotel. **16h00** sunset cruise on the Zambezi River. **18h30** optional African Spectacular Show. Dinner and overnight at the Hotel.

Day 9
Day at leisure - tour of the Falls, game of golf, Flight of the Angels, etc. Transfer to the station for a **15h00** departure from the Victoria Falls for Zimbabwe and Zambian border formalities.

Day 10
13h30 Pass through Lusaka. Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board with lectures in the morning and afternoon.

Day 11
Arrive in Kanona for a **08h00** brunch outing at Kundalila Falls. Depart from Kanona at **13h00**.

Day 12
Arrive at Nakonde/Tunduma for Zambian/Tanzanian border controls. Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board.

Day 13
10h00 Arrive in Makambako. Descend spectacular pass to Mlimba.

Day 14
01h00 Arrive in Kiduna and continue the journey through Mzenga to Dar es Salaam. Breakfast on board.
10h00 Arrive at Tazara Station, Dar Es Salaam.

14h00 Arrive in Makambako en route to Tunduma. Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board.

Day 3
07h00 Arrive in Tunduma/Nakonde for Tanzanian/Zambian border controls.

Day 4
08h00 Arrive in Kanona. Brunch outing at Kundalila Falls. Depart **12h00**. Dinner on board.

Day 5
10h00 Pass through Lusaka passing through Kafue and Choma at **12h00**. Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board.

Day 6
09h00 Arrive in Livingstone/Victoria Falls for Zambian/Zimbabwean border formalities.

12h00 Transfer to the Victoria Falls Hotel. Sunset cruise on the Zambezi River. African Spectacular Show. Dinner and overnight at the Victoria Falls Hotel.

Day 7
Day at leisure - tour of the Falls, game of golf, Flight of the Angels, river rafting, etc.

Day 8
17h00 Transfer to the station and depart Victoria Falls. Dinner and overnight on the train.

Day 9
07h00 Bypass Bulawayo en route to Plumtree with breakfast, lunch and dinner on board. Overnight on train.

Day 10
11h00 Arrive in Gabarone and transfer to 5-star Tau Game Lodge for full board two-night stay. After breakfast, guest activities i.e. Guided walk or game drive. Overnight at lodge.

Day 11
12h00 Depart from Zeerust on the Pride of Africa and travel via Magaliesberg to Pretoria.

Day 12
10h00 Arrive in Pretoria. Light lunch, city tour of Pretoria. **15h30** depart Pretoria for Cape Town.

Day 13
09h45 Kimberley. Visit to the Big Hole and the Diamond museum with historic tram ride.

Day 14
08h30 Arrive in Matjiesfontein for tour of the Village. **18h00** Arrive in Cape Town Station.

When to go: Southern Africa is a year-round destination, however, it tends to be dryer throughout most of the country in the winter months (May to October). The summer months (September through March) offer excellent weather for touring and sightseeing. The Cape region, where you will start this journey, has a unique climate with a green winter and dry summer months.

Tanzania is too a year-round destination. There are two distinct rainy seasons, from the end of March to early June and from the end of October to mid December. Rain is normally in short, sharp downpours with clear skies between. January to March it is hot and dry, June to October is warm and dry, with colder evenings.
