What distinguishes the Amazon from other tropical rain forests is the sheer number of plant and animal species that make their home here. Biologically, it is the richest and most diverse region in the world. The Amazon is also the largest tropical rain forest in the world, covering 2.3 million square miles over nine countries, including Peru, Colombia, Venezuela and Bolivia. The largest chunk, about 60% falls within Brazil's borders. The lifeline of the forest is the Amazon River itself, the second longest in the world and the largest in terms of water flow and drainage area.

During your stay at the Anavilhanas Lodge, enjoy learning about this amazing area through a variety of different activities and excursions.

Day One: Manaus - Anavilhanas Lodge

This morning you are picked up from your hotel and transferred overland (approximately 3 hours) to your lodge. After lunch, tour through the Anavilhanas archipelago in regional boats. Enjoy dinner and in the evening, embark on alligator spottings.

Day Two: Anavilhanas Lodge

After breakfast, depart the lodge for a hike through the jungle. After lunch back at the lodge, visit the pink-dolphins feeding spot and regional craft shops in Novo Airao.

Day Three: Anavilhanas Lodge

Wake up early this morning for sunrise contemplation and bird watching by canoes. Return to the lodge for breakfast followed by piranha fishing. This afternoon, visit the Tiririca's community for an introduction to their customs and some of their costumes.

Day Four: Anavilhanas Lodge - Manaus

After breakfast, enjoy canoeing through the region's creeks and flooded forests. After lunch, depart for Manaus.
