With the help of the African Wildlife Foundation, Earthwatch scientists, and local communities, the Grévy's zebra and its habitat are being studied in detail. The endangered Grévy's zebra is now only found mainly in the Samburu region of Kenya—fewer than 3,000. 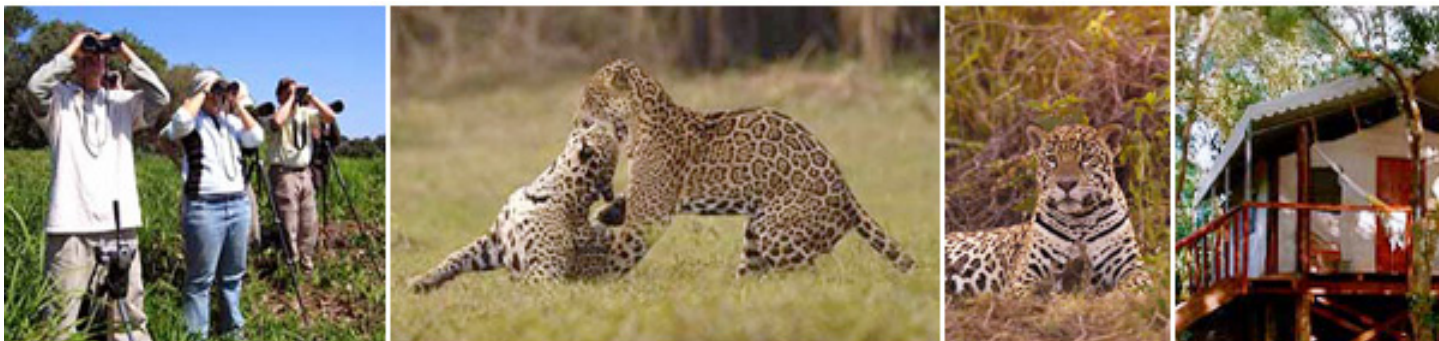

Track Jaguars in Brazil

Brazil's Pantanal region is home to one of the largest populations of the endangered jaguar. Travel to the remote Jaguar Research Center in the Meeting of the Waters State Park, where you'll stay in modern, high-tech tents, complete with wooden floors, private bathrooms with hot showers, and electricity. A high concentration of jaguars in the area makes it more likely to spot these large cats during observation tours.
