

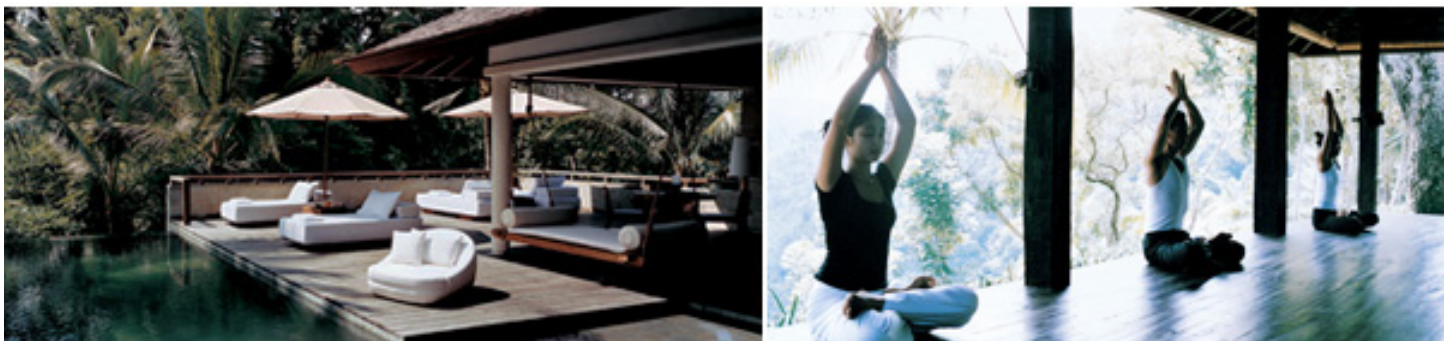

Maya Site of Copan

The ruins of Copán are one of the most important sites of the Mayan civilization. The ruined citadel and imposing public squares reveal the three main stages of development before the city was abandoned in the early 10th century.

Río Plátano Biosphere Reserve

One of the few remaining tropical rainforests in Central America, the reserve has an abundant and varied plant and wildlife. In its mountainous landscape sloping down to the Caribbean coast, over 2,000 indigenous people have preserved their traditional way of life.
