Day One Arrive Cairo

Arrive in Cairo. You will be met and transferred to your hotel, located in Cairo, overlooking the Nile River.

Day Two Pyramids

This morning you visit one of the Seven Wonders of the ancient world, the Great Pyramids at Giza. Here you will visit the Solar Boat Museum. The afternoon is spent visiting Memphis and Saqqara, its entire complex designed by Imhotep, who was perhaps the first recorded genius in history. Here you will see the Step Pyramid, the earliest of all pyramids. This evening attend the Sound & Light Show at the Pyramids.

Day Three Cairo

Today tour of the highlights of Islamic and Coptic Cairo., Citadel and Ben Ezra Synagogue, as well as the Gayer Anderson Museum and Ibn Tulun Mosque. Lunch is at Naguib Mahfous Restaurant. Remainder of afternoon is at leisure to wander through the maze of alleyways in the Khan el-Khalili Souq.

Day Four Cairo/Abu Simbel/Aswan B
 Early morning transfer to the Cairo Airport for your flight onto Abu Simbel and a tour of the famous Temples of Ramses II. Following board your flight to Aswan. Here you will be met and transferred to your hotel. This afternoon visit the High Dam, the granite quarries and the Temple of Philae. Time permitting enjoy a sunset felucca cruise to the nearby Nubian village. Evening enjoy a stroll through Aswan's Nubian market.
Old Cataract Hotel [Luxury Nile view room]

Optional: Visit the Nubian Museum.

Day Five Aswan/Kom Ombo/Edfu/Luxor B, L
 Today is a full day's drive to Luxor, enroute visiting the ancient sites of Kom Ombo and Edfu before arriving in Luxor late this afternoon. In Kom Ombo visit the temple shared by the gods Sobek and Haroeris. In Edfu visit the famed temple of Horus. The drive takes you through villages and along the Nile River. You will also visit the ancient capital of El Kab enroute.
Hilton Luxor Resort [Deluxe Nile view room]

Day Six Luxor B
 This morning visit the West Bank and its Valley of Kings and the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and Colossi of Memnon. You will also visit the tomb of Ramses VI with its exquisite hieroglyphics. The decorative designs in this tomb are the most sophisticated and complete in the Valley of the Kings

Optional: Hot air balloon flight over the West Bank is available for an additional: approximately \$200 per person. [Please note that this flight is a 'shared experience']

Day Seven Luxor B, L
 This morning drive to Dendarah to the remarkable Temple of Hathor – one of the best preserved ancient monuments in Egypt. Late this afternoon return to Luxor. This evening attend the Sound & Light Show at Karnak.

Day Eight Luxor to Cairo B
 This morning visit the Luxor Museum, Karnak and Luxor temples. Later this afternoon fly from Luxor to Cairo, and transfer to your hotel.
Four Seasons at Nile Plaza [Deluxe Nile view room]

Day Nine Cairo B
 Today you will visit the renowned Egyptian Museum, which houses many spectacular treasures of Tutankhamun. You will also tour the Mummy Room of the museum. Remainder of the afternoon at leisure.

Day Ten Depart Egypt B
 Transfer to the Airport this morning for your flight onward.

Important Notes:

- As this tour is operated on an individual basis, hotel accommodations availability is according to the clients' dates of travel. Please be aware that minimum night stay requirements may apply during the Christmas & New Year holiday season.
- A visa is required for travelers visiting Egypt. Cox & Kings provides Egyptian visas for American and Canadian passport holders. Other nationalities should check with the Egyptian Embassy in their country for visa requirements that may apply.
- The ideal time to visit Egypt is September through May when the weather is at its best and most comfortable.
- Certain monuments and tourist attractions in the Middle East are closed on certain days for religious/holiday reasons. If in the event your visit to any of these cities falls on a day when these sites are closed, your tour will be adjusted accordingly. Please also note that this program requires extensive walking over uneven and rocky terrain and some long days of touring with early morning starts.

-To confirm your reservations a \$750 per person deposit is required. Additional deposits may be required for travel over the Holiday Season (Christmas, New Year and Easter).
