Day 1: Arrive La Paz

Upon arrival in La Paz, you will be welcomed by your Cox & Kings local representative and escorted to your hotel. This evening, enjoy typical Bolivian cuisine at a local restaurant. **La Casona Boutique Hotel – 2 nights (D)**

Day 2: Lake Titicaca

Enjoy a full day of exploration on Lake Titicaca, including a visit to Isla del Sol, the birthplace of the Inca Empire. Continue to the Inti Wata Cultural Complex, which features the underground museum of Ekako, a display of traditional shipbuilding with reeds, a handicraft center, and an exhibit about the agricultural terraces of the Incas. Conclude your time on the lake with a cruise and a visit to the Pilkokaina Inca Palace. **(B, L)**

Day 3: To Concepcion

After breakfast, head to the airport for your short flight to Santa Cruz. Upon arrival, you will be met by a local Cox & Kings representative and escorted to the colonial town of Concepcion. En-route, you will stop to visit

the Jesuit Mission of San Javier. **Concepcion Hotel – 1 night (B, L)**

Day 4: To Santa Cruz

After breakfast continue your visit to the UNESCO World Heritage Chiquitania Missions, which are the only Jesuit missions in Latin America in their original condition. On your guided visit, discover the history and culture behind the famous churches, which include San Rafael, San Miguel, and Santa Ana, before returning to Santa Cruz. **Camino Real Hotel – 1 night (B, L)**

Day 5: To Sucre

This morning, you will be escorted to the airport for your flight to Sucre. Upon arrival, visit the city, including the indigenous art museum. Conclude with a visit to the Casa de la Libertad and the main plaza of Sucre. **Parador Hotel – 2 nights (B)**

Enjoy a unique experience during your exploration of the indigenous town of Tarabuco, which is one of the few places

Day 7: To Potosí

After a morning at leisure, continue to Potosí where you have the rest of the day to acclimate to the altitude or begin your explorations of the town. **Coloso Hotel – 2 nights (B)**

Day 8: Potosí

After breakfast, discover Potosí and the surrounding area. Known for centuries as the richest and highest city in the world, Potosí

sits atop the Cerro Rico, one of the greatest mineral deposits in the entire world. After exploring the National Mint, visit a working mine where you will learn about the process of extracting silver from the earth. **(B, L)**

Day 9: To La Paz

Bid farewell to Bolivia this morning as you are escorted back to Sucre for your short flight to La Paz. Upon arrival, connect with your onward flight. **(B)**
