Day 1: Arrive in Singapore

Welcome to Singapore!

After clearing custom and immigration formalities, you will be met by your Cox & Kings representative and escorted to your hotel.

Singapore has a diverse populace of just over 5 million people which is made up of Chinese, Malays, Indians, Caucasians and Eurasians residents of many other origins, which is in line with the nation's history as a crossroads for various ethnic and racial groups.

The remainder of the day is at leisure.

Day 2: Singapore

The morning is at leisure. Take a stroll through the riverfront Merlion Park or the orchid-filled gardens of the Singapore Botanical Gardens.

At 1:30 pm, meet your guide and proceed for your 60-minute Vintage Vespa Sidecar tour of Kampong Glam, Haji Lane and Little India.

The tour starts at Kampong Glam, formerly the seat of Malay royalty. Here you'll see the Sultan Mosque, Singapore's oldest and largest, and the former Sultan's palace of Istana Kampong Glam. From here, the tour goes to colorful Haji Lane, the original hipster neighborhood where a row of

multi-label stores, quirky boutiques and hip bars and cafes line the lanes. Lastly you will be also visiting Little India, a buzzing historic area that shows off the best of Singapore's Indian community from vibrant culture to incredible shopping.

The rest of the day is at leisure. In the later afternoon you can arrange for an optional visit to the Gardens by the Bay for a walk amongst the soaring Supertree Grove or through the Cloud Forest and Flower Dome conservatories. **Marina Mandarin (B)**

Day 3: Singapore

This morning meet your guide for your Journeys Heritage Tour. Starting at Fort Canning Hill, the tour goes beyond just the serene beauty of the park to uncover 14th century Singapura through vestiges of its fascinating history. Highlights include the Keramat Iskandar Shah, the Spice Gardens and the Battle Box.

Following lunch at The Salon, the journey continues to Chinatown Heritage. Set within three beautifully-restored shophouses on

Pagoda Street, the Chinatown Heritage Centre recreates the original interiors of the 1950s, offering a rare glimpse into the lives of Chinatown's early residents.

Then, visit the Haw Par Villa for unforgettable journey through its whimsical landscape. Built in 1937, this wonderful theme park is famous for its depictions of Chinese folklore's 10 Courts of Hell and tasteful scenes from other Chinese legends, such as Journey to the West and Madame White Snake. Pick your favorite from the over 1,000 colorful statues and tableaux on display at the world's only eclectic Chinese mythological park of its kind.

Later return to your hotel and the rest of the day is free at leisure. The optional Night Safari is the first of its' kind, where trams and walking trails guide visitors through the 100-acre jungle. **Marina Mandarin (B, L)**
