Day 1: Arrive La Paz, Bolivia

Upon arrival in La Paz, you will be welcomed and escorted to your hotel. This evening enjoy dinner in a typical Bolivian local restaurant. *La Casona Boutique Hotel – 1 night (D)*

Day 2: To Uyuni

This morning, take a flight to Uyuni, home to the largest salt flats on earth. After visiting the village of Colchani, head to Isla Pescado, which is located in the middle of the salt flats. *Luna Salada Hotel – 2 nights (B, L, D)*

Day 3: Uyuni

Embark upon a breathtaking drive across the salt flats on a full-day exploration to Tunupa Volcano. Upon arrival, take a short hike to visit the mummies in the village of Coquesa. Then head up the slopes to nearly 15,000 feet for an incredible view of the landscape. Enjoy lunch in Coquesa and a visit with the local llama and flamingo before returning to your hotel. (B, L)

Day 4: To Isla del Sol

After visiting the otherworldly Valley of the

Moon, travel to the shores of Lake Titicaca. Sail to Isla del Sol where you check in to your resort and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure. *Isla Del Sol Eco Lodge – 1 night (B, D)*

Day 5: To Puno

Journey to the shores of Lake Titicaca. In the late afternoon, enjoy kayaking at over 12,000 feet, where the clear skies allow you to truly appreciate the intensity of the spectacular landscape. *Titilaka – 2 nights (B, L, D)*

Day 6: Puno

Enjoy a full day on Lake Titicaca, including a visit to the legendary floating islands of Uros where you will meet a traditional family. This afternoon, hike along a rural community path, a perfect introduction to the rural lifestyle that dominates most of the Peruvian *altiplano*. (B, L, D)

Day 7: To Cusco

After breakfast, you will be escorted to the airport for your flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, visit the Inca ceremonial site of Sacsayhuaman, which lies just outside

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of town; the Plaza de Armas; and Santo Domingo Monastery. Then explore the incredible collection of artifacts at the Pre-Columbian Art Museum.

Inkaterra La Casona – 2 nights (B, L)

Day 8: Cusco

Visit the local community of Inca Trail porters and Peruvian weavers in Willoq. Discover the imposing fortress of Ollantaytambo. Relish an al fresco lunch at Wayra Ranch, including a demonstration of horsemanship and a performance of traditional Marinera dance. Then search for treasures at the Pisac handicraft market. **(B, L)**

Day 9: To Machu Picchu

Early this morning, board the Vistadome train to Machu Picchu. Rediscovered in 1911

by Hiram Bingham, Machu Picchu is the only Inca city to remain intact. Take a guided tour of the citadel's agricultural terraces, royal houses and temples. In the afternoon, explore the ruins on your own. **Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo – 1 night (B, L, D)**

Day 10: To Cusco

Plan to visit early this morning to see the sunrise over the ruins. In the afternoon, return by train to Cusco. **Inkaterra La Casona – 1 night (B, L)**

Day 11: Depart Cusco

This morning, fly to Lima to meet your onward flight. **(B)**
